CARNIVAL IN GERMANY

7 Days - 8 Nights

The tradition of carnival in Germany has been around since the 13th century, when the celebration was held to expel winter and ward off the ghosts that threaten the crops. The carnival (or Mardi-Gras) in southern Germany, which is known as the „Swabian-Alemannic“ carnival, is very different from the much younger version of the Rhenish Carnival. The Swabian-Alemannic Carnival has a very long tradition. Its carnival parades are the most authentic, original and fun folklore celebrations in the Black Forest.

Day 1 | Sunday - Frankfurt

Arrival at Frankfurt airport and transfer to the hotel. The rest of the day is free to spend at your leisure. Frankfurt is the financial and commercial heart of Germany, a city full of fascinating contrasts between modern development and historic landmarks. Watch the traditional carnival parade in the city center (without a guide). The parade starts in the afternoon and more than a hundred carnival associations participate. Overnight in Frankfurt at a 4-Star hotel.

Day 2 | Monday Frankfurt - Heidelberg - Freiburg

In the morning we travel from Frankfurt to Heidelberg. Visit the famous castle ascending with the cable car and enjoy a sightseeing tour of its historic city center. Idyllically located on the shores of the Neckar River, Heidelberg is Germany's oldest university town and one of the most popular destinations in the country. We continue to the famous Black Forest region. Our next stop is Freiburg. Overnight in Freiburg at a 4-Star hotel.

Day 3 | Tuesday

Freiburg - Black Forest - Constance

After breakfast, enjoy a sightseeing tour of the city. Then it is time to attend one of the famous carnival parades in the Black Forest, the so-called "Narrensprung". Also known as the "fifth season of the year", this carnival is a very traditional celebration that is held throughout the region. In the afternoon, you arrive in Constance. In the evening, the carnival celebrations are concluded with the traditional burning of the carnival figures. Overnight in Constance at a 4-Star hotel.

Day 4 | Wednesday

Constance - Lindau - Füssen

Enjoy a sightseeing tour of the city of Constance. Discover this modern and young city on the banks of Lake Constance and the Rhine River. During the walk through the old town, you will see that Constance has remained virtually unchanged since the Middle Ages. Today this is a thriving university city with a wide range of leisure options. The trip continues to the small island of Lindau with spectacular views of the Alps. Today's final destination is Füssen, the southernmost point on this route of Romantic Germany. Overnight in Füssen at a 4-Star hotel.

Day 5 | Thursday Innsbruck - Munich

In the morning we enjoy a sightseeing tour of Innsbruck (Austria), located in the Inn valley, in the heart of the Alps. The Imperial Palace, the Court Church and of course the well-known Golden Roof, Innsbruck's glittering landmark are all witnesses of this culturally rich city. In the afternoon we travel to Munich. Overnight in Munich at a 4-Star hotel.



Day 6 | Friday

Munich

After breakfast we visit the city's main attractions, concluding the tour at the Marienplatz square with its famous clock tower. Munich, the capital of the state of Bavaria is famous for its Oktoberfest, which is annually celebrated in September. The afternoon is free to explore at your leisure. In the evening you enjoy a traditional Bavarian dinner. Overnight in Munich at a 4-Star hotel.

Day 7 | Saturday

Munich - Rothenburg ob der Tauber - Frankfurt

After breakfast we travel to Rothenburg ob der Tauber, one of the oldest and most beautiful cities in Romantic Germany. Sightseeing tour of his lovely medieval town and travel to Frankfurt. The program ends at Frankfurt airport, around 6 pm.
