EDINBURGH CITY BREAK 2017

5 Days | 4 Nights

Edinburgh has a medieval Old Town and elegant Georgian New Town with gardens and neoclassical buildings. The Castle is home to Scotland's Crown Jewels and the Stone of Destiny, used in the coronation of Scottish rulers. Arthur's Seat is an imposing peak in Holyrood Park with sweeping views, and Calton Hill is topped with monuments and memorials.

GLASGOW CITY BREAK

5 Days | 4 Nights

Glasgow, on the River Clyde, is famed for its Victorian and art nouveau architecture, a rich legacy of the city's 18th–20th century prosperity due to trade and shipbuilding. Today it's a national cultural hub, home to Scottish Opera, Ballet and National Theatre of Scotland, as well as acclaimed museums and a thriving music scene.

AIRTH CASTLE - EDINBURGH

The castle dates back to the 14th century and was once owned by the family of Robert the Bruce. Set in a secluded countryside location, yet conveniently located for Scotland's cities, Airth Castle Hotel & Spa is Central Scotland's premier hotel for business and pleasure.

TULLOCH CASTLE - INVERNESS

Tulloch Castle dates from the 12th century, when the Bains and later the Clan Davidson laid claim to its lands. Like its lively history, the castle's fortunes have changed many times. The castle retains many of its period features, including the 250-year old panelled Great Hall, and painstakingly restored original fireplaces and ceilings.

KILDUMMY PARK - GRAMPIANS

Nestled in the heart of the Grampian Highlands is this traditional and charming Scottish Castle Hotel. The hotel is in the centre of the whisky trail, with the Glenlivet Whisky distillery 56.3 km from the hotel and Glenfiddich's just a 40-minute drive away. Aberdeen Airport is just over 48.3 km east of the hotel and Alford Golf Club is 16.1 km away.

DALHOUSIE HOTEL - EDINBURGH

The Castle, which is situated in the parish of Cockpen, eight miles south of Edinburgh, dates from the 13th century, although only the enormously thick walls at the foundation level and the vaults remain, of the original building. The main parts of the present structure were built about 1450 from red stone quarried from the opposite bank of the South Esk River on which the Castle stands. In the succeeding centuries there have been various additions and modifications, but the essential form of the Castle which had an L-shaped keep surrounded by an outer curtain wall can still be clearly discerned.
