THE JUNGFRAU RAILWAY

Europe's highest-altitude railway station was opened on 1 August in 1912 (Swiss National Day). At 3,454 metres above sea level, the scenically spectacular Jungfrauoch – Top of Europe – became accessible to a wider public. The idea of building a railway up the Jungfrau Mountain came to Adolf Guyer-Zeller, an already renowned railway-pioneer, while hiking in the Jungfrau Region in 1893. Captivated by the towering trio – Eiger, Mönch & Jungfrau, he jotted down notes and sketches which corresponded very-closely to the subsequent planning and construction of the Jungfrau Railway. Others before him had dreamed of building what became known as the 'railway to the sky'.

- 1st class seat reservation for Golden Pass - Lucerne - Interlaken Express
- Excursions to Mt Titlis with Ice-Flyer chairlift, Jungfrauoch & the Gornergrat (2nd class only)
- 2 nights Lucerne, 2 nights Interlaken, 2 nights Zermatt, in a room with private facilities and breakfast daily
- Any additional tickets for optional excursions to travel by rail, boat, postal-coaches and cable-cars can be purchased at 25–50% off the regular fares

Day 1 | Arrive in Lucerne

Travel by train in 1st class from Swiss border or airport railway station to Lucerne. Optional excursion, if time permits, to Mt Pilatus. Overnight in Lucerne.

Day 2 | Lucerne to Mount Titlis

Enjoy a ride in the first revolving gondola to Mount Titlis reaching to the height of 3,020m. In Lucerne board the Lucerne-Engelberg Express to Engelberg. There a small gondola takes you up to the Trübsee. You continue your trip by another gondola to Stand. Finally the revolving gondola takes you up to Mount Titlis. For a close-up insight into a glacier, you visit the Glacier Cave and ride the Ice Flyer chairlift. Overnight in Lucerne. (B)

Day 3 | Lucerne to Interlaken

Train journey from the city of Lucerne to Interlaken over the Brünig Pass via the wood-carving village of Brienz. Overnight in Interlaken. (B)

Day 4 | Jungfrauoch Excursion

The beautiful Bernese Oberland! Travel from Interlaken Ost via Grindelwald or Wengen to the Kleine Scheidegg, at the foot of the famous Eiger North Wall. Then, take the Jungfrau Railway via the Eiger Glacier to the Jungfrauoch – at 3,454m the highest railway station in Europe! Experience amazing views of the Aletsch Glacier, the longest glacier in the Alps. Overnight in Interlaken. (B)

Day 5 | Interlaken to Zermatt

Travel to Zermatt, at the foot of the Matterhorn which is the perfect alpine resort! On arrival you may take the opportunity to go on an optional excursion to Rothorn Paradise to enjoy the best view of the Matterhorn! Overnight in Zermatt. (B)

Day 6 | Gornergrat Excursion

Board the cogwheel railway up to the Gornergrat, with views of the majestic Matterhorn, Monte Rosa and other spectacular summits! Overnight in Zermatt. (B)

Day 7 | Depart Zermatt

Depart Zermatt by train to Swiss border or airport railway station or alternatively continue your stay in Switzerland! (B)
