Day 2 | Lucerne - Lugano

Train journey from Lucerne to Lugano. Experience the new Gotthard Base Tunnel with its 57 kilometres it is the longest train tunnel in the world. It takes only 17 minutes to travel this flat-track route under the Alpine massif in the heart of Europe. Overnight in Lugano.

Day 3 | Lugano

Time at leisure in Lugano. Enjoy the Mediterranean atmosphere in the Southern part of Switzerland. Stroll along the lakeside promenade or go up to Monte Brè or San Salvatore. Overnight in Lugano. (B)

Day 4 | Bernina Express to St. Moritz

Depart by the Bernina Express (coach) to Tirano (Italy). Continue by train over the Mount Bernina to St. Moritz. This exciting trip takes you through three cultures from palm trees across the regions of eternal snow to the valley of the Rhine! Overnight in St. Moritz. (B)

Day 5 | St. Moritz

Day at leisure. St. Moritz is the original Swiss winter holiday-resort, a fashionable mountain-resort world-famous for its skiing, fantastic scenery and its relaxing spas! Overnight in St. Moritz. (B)

Day 1 | Arrive Lucerne

Day 8 | Depart Zermatt

Depart Zermatt for Swiss border or airport rail station or alternatively continue your stay in Switzerland. (B)
