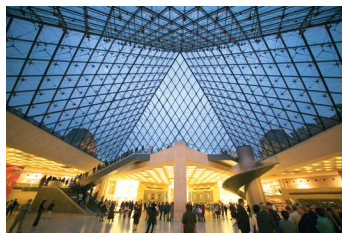


## FEATURED FRANCE TOURS - EXTEND YOUR HOLIDAY

## CITY TOUR &amp; EIFFEL TOWER

## 2-DAY NORMANDY, SAINT MALO &amp; MONT SAINT MICHEL TOUR

## THU: NORMANDY

Take the Normandy motorway and make the first stop at Rouen for a walking tour in the old town before continuing to Honfleur. On the way between Rouen and Honfleur, view of the newly built Normandy bridge. In Honfleur: free time for lunch (not included). Continue to the D-Day Landing Beaches of Normandy and visit the American Cemetery at Omaha Beach and make a short stop at Arromanches where one of the two Mulberry Harbours was built. Dinner and overnight stay at a 3-star hotel in Caen.

## FRI: ST MALO, MONT ST MICHEL

Depart Caen and drive to Saint-Malo, the pirate city, located in the Brittany region. Guided visit of the town including a walk along the ramparts and a visit of the Cathedral. After lunch (not included) we depart for Mont-Saint-Michel (on the frontier between the Brittany and Normandy regions). We continue our afternoon with a guided visit of the abbey and free time for strolling and shopping. Depart around 4.30 pm. Stop on the way back to Paris. Arrival around 9.15 pm.

## MONTMARTRE &amp; THE LOUVRE

Take a city tour through the Latin Quarter and the Marais, in the heart of the Paris student and cultural life. Guided tours of Notre Dame Cathedral, Montmartre (Place du Tertre and Sacré-Coeur), and the Louvre Museum. Opportunity to spend time at the Louvre and the Sacré-Coeur Basilica.

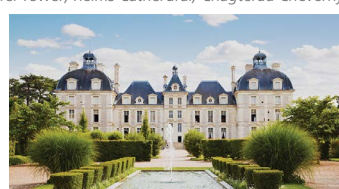
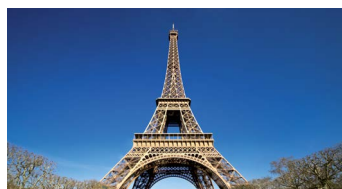
