Day 2 | Interlaken – Bern – Gruyères – Geneva

After breakfast depart Interlaken and drive along the Lake of Thun to the Swiss capital, Bern. A city tour to the Old Town includes the Clock Tower, Kramgasse, and the 15th century Cathedral of St. Vincent. A drive south takes you to the scenic dairy farmlands of Gruyères, a hilltop town, preserved against time with its medieval castle. A visit to a milk products plant is a further highlight of the day. Continue to the Swiss Riviera, arriving Geneva, the most cosmopolitan city of Switzerland, late afternoon. Overnight in Geneva at a superior tourist-class hotel. (B)

Day 3 | Geneva – Montreux – Zermatt

This morning depart with a city tour of Geneva. Late morning depart Geneva and drive to Lausanne and Montreux. Pass by Chillon Castle, the 13th century fortress made famous by Lord Byron's poem. Time for lunch in Montreux. In the afternoon, proceed through the Valais, the valley of the Rhone River with its orchards and vineyards. At Täsch, board a cogwheel train that takes you to Zermatt at the foot of the Matterhorn. Dinner and overnight in Zermatt at a first-class hotel. (B,D)

Day 4 | Zermatt – Nufenen Pass – Zurich

Morning at leisure in Zermatt. Just relax or take an optional cogwheel train up to Gornergrat for a spectacular view of the surrounding snow-covered peaks! In the afternoon, board the train to Täsch where the bus is waiting to take you over the breathtaking Nufenen Pass to Airolo. Return to Zurich by bus or train. Arrive in Zurich at approx. 6:30 pm. (B)

As the tour ends late in the day, consider pre-booking a night in Zurich or other arrangements.

Day 1 | Zurich – Lucerne – Mt. Titlis – Interlaken

Depart Zurich at 8.30 am. A short drive takes you to Lucerne to visit the Lion Monument and a walk on the 14th century Chapel Bridge. At noon travel to the mountain resort of Engelberg. A cable-car ride to the summit of Mount Titlis takes you up into the high alpine region with its glaciers and eternal ice. Enjoy a magnificent ride in the revolving 'ROTAIR' gondola. In the afternoon cross the Brunig Pass to the Bernese Oberland to Brienz, where you will see woodcarvers at work. Continue to the holiday resort of Interlaken at the foot of Jungfrau mountain. Dinner on your own. Overnight at a first-class hotel.

Day 2 | Interlaken – Bern – Gruyères – Geneva

Depart Interlaken and drive along beautiful Lake Thun to the Swiss capital, Bern. The city is attractively set on a steep-sided curve of the River Aare and backed by the majestic Alps. A city tour to the Old Town includes the Clock Tower, Kramgasse, and the 15th century Cathedral of St. Vincent. A drive south takes you to the scenic dairy farmlands, to Gruyères. A beautiful hilltop town, preserved against time, which could be the magical setting for fairytales with its impressive, medieval castle. Continue your drive to the Vaud. Dinner on your own. Overnight at superior tourist-class hotel. (B)

Day 3 | Geneva – Montreux – Zermatt

City tour of Geneva this morning. Highlights include: the old town with its cathedral; the unique town-hall and the European seat of the United Nations. Late morning depart Geneva and drive to Lausanne and Montreux. Pass by Chillon Castle, the 13th century fortress made famous by Lord Byron's poem. In the afternoon travel through the Valais to Täsch and board a cogwheel train that takes you to the mountain resort of Zermatt. Dinner and overnight at first-class hotel. (B,D)

Day 4 | Zermatt

Day at leisure in Zermatt! Dinner and overnight at a first-class hotel. (B,D)

Day 5 | (unescorted) Zermatt – Glacier Express Train – St. Moritz

Today you will travel on the legendary 'Glacier Express Train'. You board the train in Zermatt in the morning and a magnificent travelling day is ahead of you. Seated in a comfortable 2nd class compartment. During the journey a delicious 3-course lunch is served at your seat. In the late afternoon arrive at St. Moritz. Dinner and overnight at first-class hotel. (B,L,D)

Day 6 | St. Moritz – Vaduz – Zurich

Depart St. Moritz in the morning and cross the Fluela Pass to reach Davos. In the capital of Principality of Liechtenstein, Vaduz, there will be time for lunch and for sightseeing. This tiny country is the home of the present Prince and his family, attracts visitors from all over the world. In the afternoon return to Zurich through the Toggenburg region with its picturesque farmhouses. Arrive in Zurich at approx. 5 pm. (B)
