Glacier Express

Zermatt - Brig - Andermatt - Davos / St-Moritz

Today you board the Glacier Express which is one of the greatest train journeys in the world. The 8-hour journey the world's slowest express train takes you across 291 bridges, through 91 tunnels and across the Oberalp Pass at 2033 m. Travel in comfort through the unspoilt natural beauty of a landscape rich in ancient, fragrant mountain forests, peaceful Alpine meadows and mountain streams. Seat reservations are compulsory. Price on application.

Golden Pass Panoramic

Lucerne - Brünig Pass - Interlaken - Montreux

Connect Central Switzerland and Lake Geneva with this attractive train-ride. Depart from historic Lucerne and cross the Brünig Pass by Lucerne-Interlaken Express train, to Interlaken. Continue on to Gstaad, where the train makes an electrifying descent towards Montreux, passing through vineyards and country estates to finally arrive at Lake Geneva. Seat reservations are highly recommended. Price on application.

Bernina Express

Chur / Davos - St. Moritz - Bernina Pass - Poschiavo - Tirano (bus) - Lugano

The Bernina Express offers breath-taking vistas from the beautiful 1st and 2nd class panoramic cars. Travel over graceful viaducts, through galleries hewn into the sheer rock, through switch-back tunnels, along rushing mountain streams, glaciers and even an alpine garden! The entire trip is narrated. Seat reservations are compulsory. Price on application.

Gotthard Panorama Express

Lucerne - Flüelen - Gotthard Tunnel - Bellinzona - Lugano

Stream along the coastline of Lake Lucerne on a first-class vintage paddle-steamer. When the steamer reaches Flüelen, step-off the boat and on to the comfort of a first-class panoramic train that will whisk you via the spectacular Gotthard route to Bellinzona and continue to Lugano. Formerly The William Tell Express. Seat reservations are compulsory. Price on application.

Palm Express

St. Moritz - Chiavenna - Lugano

The scenic Palm Express PostBus journey commences in St. Moritz and takes you on a 4-hour trip from the glaciers of Engadine to the swaying palms of Lugano. Note: The Eurail Pass is NOT valid on the Palm Express. Passengers therefore require additional sector tickets. Seat reservations on the Palm Express are compulsory. Price on application.

Swiss Travel Pass (Consecutive Days)

Unlimited travel on trains, buses and boats including premium trains, plus public transport in more than 90 towns and cities. Available for 3, 4, 8 or 15 days.

Swiss Transfer Ticket

Valid for one month. Includes return travel by train bus and boat from a Swiss Border station or airport to a Swiss destination and return. Conditions apply.

Swiss Travel Pass Flex

Choose from 3, 4, 8 or 15 days nonconsecutive days within a month.

Swiss Half Fare Card

Valid for 1 month. Up to 50% reduction of travel by train, bus and boat as well as some mountain railways and public transport in more than 90 towns and cities. Conditions apply.

Swiss Family Card

Available free of charge and on request when purchasing any regular Swiss Travel System ticket. Children under 16 travel free of charge when accompanied by at least one parent with a valid Swiss Travel System Ticket.
